

## Communicator of Achievement Award

Nominations are being accepted until March 1, 2013 from the KPC membership for the Communicator of Achievement award, National Federation of Press Women's highest honor.

All nominees must be living members in good standing for at least two years in an affiliate and National Federation of Press Women. Nominees should have high professional qualifications and professional achievement; hold a position of responsibility in the field of communications; have made some important contribution to their profession and to their community through their work; have made some impact on the industry; and be role models, with integrity and good character.

NFPW's judging criteria considers the following:

- 60% of the judging is based on professional achievement. All nominees should have high professional qualifications and achievements in their areas of the communications field (for example, public relations, newspapers, magazines, advertising, freelance writing, editing, electronic media, or any field that has qualified the nominee for NFPW membership).
- 20% of the judging is based on community service. Each nominee should have made some impact on the world beyond her or his profession some contribution to humanity. That impact or contribution may be through the profession or beyond it.
- 20% of the judging is based on NFPW and affiliate service. Each nominee should have made a definite and important contribution to her or his affiliate and to NFPW.

Nominations *MUST* include a 250-word narrative indicating the nominee's professional achievements, community service, and service to NFPW and the affiliate.
